¹A revelation of Jesus Christ, which God gave to Him to show His slaves the things which are necessary to happen in speed. And He signified, sending through His messenger to His slave John, ² who testified the word of God and the testimony of Jesus Christ, as many things as he saw.

³Blessed is the one reading, and those hearing the words of the prophecy, and guarding the things having been written in it, for the season is near.

⁴ John, to the seven assemblies – those in Asia:

Grace to you and peace from God: He Who is, and He Who was, and He Who is coming and from the seven spirits which are before His throne, ⁵ and from Jesus Christ, the faithful Witness, the Firstborne from the dead, and the Superior of the kings of the earth. To the One being devoted to us and having washed us from our sins in His blood. ⁶ And He made us a kingdom, priests to His God and Father. To Him belong the glory and the might into the ages of the ages. Amen. ⁷Behold: He is coming with the clouds, and every eye will see Him, and those who pierced Him. And all the tribes of the earth will mourn over Him. Yes! Amen!

⁸ "I am the Alpha and the Omega" says the Lord God, "He Who is, and He Who was, and He Who is coming – the Almighty."

⁹I, John, your brother and partner in the affliction, and kingdom, and endurance in Christ Jesus, came to be on the island called Patmos through the Word of God and through the testimony of Jesus Christ. ¹⁰I came to be in Spirit on the Lord's day, and I heard a voice behind me, great as a trumpet, ¹¹ saying, "That which you are seeing write in a scroll and send to the seven assemblies: to Ephesus, and to Smyrna, and to Pergamos, and to Thyatira, and to Sardis, and to Philadelphia, and to Laodicea." ¹² And there I turned to be seeing the voice which was speaking with me. And turning, I saw seven golden lampstands, ¹³ and in the midst of the seven lampstands, like a son of man, having been clothed in a robe reaching to the feet, and having been girded across the breasts with a golden belt, ¹⁴ and His head and hair white, and like white wool, like snow, and His eyes like a flame of fire, ¹⁵ and His feet like chalkolibanon, as having been fired in a furnace, and His voice like a sound of many waters, ¹⁶ and having in His right hand seven stars, and proceeding out of His mouth a sharp, double-mouthed sword, and His face as the sun is shining in its power. ¹⁷ And when I saw Him, I fell at His feet as dead. And He put His right hand on me, saying, "Don't be fearing; I am the First and the Last, ¹⁸ and the Living One, and I became dead, and behold: I am living into the ages of the ages. Amen. And I am holding the keys of death and of Hades. ¹⁹ Write therefore the things you saw, and the things which are, and the things which are about to happen after these.²⁰ The secret of the seven stars which you saw on My right and the seven golden

lampstands: The seven stars are the messengers of the seven assemblies, and the seven lampstands are seven assemblies.

Revelation 2

¹ "To the messenger of the assembly in Ephesus write, 'He holding the seven stars in His right, He walking in the midst of the seven golden lampstands is saying these things:

² ""I have known your works, and your toil, and your endurance, and that you aren't able to bear evil people. And you tested those asserting that they are apostles and they aren't, and have found them false; ³ and you are having endurance, and you persevered through My name, and didn't become fatigued.

⁴ ""But I am having against you that you left your first devotion.

⁵ ""Therefore be remembering from where you have fallen, and change your mind, and do the first works; but if not, I am coming to you with speed, and I will remove your lampstand out of its place – unless you change your mind. ⁶ But you are having this: that you are hating the works of the Nicolaitans, which I also am hating.

⁷ ""The one having an ear, let him hear what the Spirit is saying to the assemblies. To the one overcoming I will give to him to eat from the tree of life which is in the Paradise of My God.""

⁸ "And to the messenger of the assembly in Smyrna write, 'The First and the Last, Who became dead and lived is saying these things: ⁹I have known your works, and your affliction, and poverty (but you are rich); and the blasphemy of those claiming to be Jews and they aren't, but are a synagogue of Satan.

¹⁰ "Be fearing nothing which you are about to be suffering. Behold: indeed, the slanderer is about to be throwing some of you into prison, so that you may be tempted, and you will have affliction ten days. Be becoming faithful up to death, and I will give to you the winner's crown of life.

¹¹ "'The one having an ear, let him hear what the Spirit is saying to the assemblies. The one overcoming will certainly not be wronged from the second death.'

¹² "And to the messenger of the assembly in Pergamos write, 'The one having the sharp double-mouthed sword is saying these things: ¹³ "I have known your works, and where you are dwelling, where Satan's throne is. And you are holding on to My name, and you didn't deny My faith in the days in which Antipas, my faithful witness was killed beside you, where Satan is dwelling.

¹⁴ ""But I am having a few things against you, because you are having there some holding on to the teaching of Balaam, who taught Balak to throw a snare before the sons of Israel, even to eat things sacrificed to idols and to fornicate. ¹⁵ Thus, likewise, you also are having some holding on to the teaching of Nicolaitans.

¹⁶ ""Therefore change your minds! But if not, I am coming to you with speed and I will war with them by the sword of My mouth.

¹⁷ ""The one having an ear, let him hear what the Spirit is saying to the assemblies. To the one overcoming, I will give to him of the hidden manna. And I will give to him a white pebble, and on the pebble a new name having been written which no one has known except the one receiving."

¹⁸ "And to the messenger of the assembly in Thyatira write, 'The Son of God, the One having His eyes like a flame of fire and His feet like chalkolibanon is saying these things:

¹⁹ ""I have known your works, and devotion, and belief, and service, and your endurance; and your last works are more than the first.

²⁰ ""But I am having against you that you are tolerating your wife, Jezebel, who is calling herself a prophetess, and is teaching and deceiving My slaves to fornicate and to eat things sacrificed to idols. ²¹ And I gave to her time so that she should change her mind, and she isn't wanting to change her mind from her fornication. ²² Behold: I am throwing her into a bed, and those committing adultery with her into great affliction, if they won't change their minds from her works. ²³ And her children I will kill in death. And all the assemblies will know that I am the One searching kidneys and hearts. And I will give to you, to each, according to your works.

²⁴ ""But to you I am saying – to the rest who are in Thyatira – as many as aren't holding this teaching, who didn't know the depths of Satan, as they are saying, I'm not casting on you another weight. ²⁵ Nevertheless, hold fast what you are having until which time I will come. ²⁶ And the one overcoming and the one keeping My works until the end, I will give to him authority over the nations, ²⁷ and he will shepherd them with an iron rod; like the potter's vessels they will be broken, as I also have received from My Father. ²⁸ And I will give to him the morningstar.

²⁹ ""The one having an ear, let him hear what the Spirit is saying to the assemblies.""

Revelation 3

¹ "And to the messenger of the assembly in Sardis write, 'The One having the seven spirits of God and the seven stars is saying these things:

""I have known your works, that you are having a name, and you are living, and you are dead. ²Be watching, and guard the things remaining which you were about to throw away, for I haven't found your works having been filled before My God.

³ ""Be remembering therefore how you have received and heard, and be guarding and change your mind. Therefore, if you don't watch, I will come upon you like a thief, and you certainly won't know what hour I will come upon you. ⁴ But you are having a few names in Sardis which didn't smear their garments; and they will walk with Me in white, because they are worthy. ⁵ The one overcoming, this one will be arrayed in white garments, and I will certainly not blot out his name from the Scroll of the life, and I will confess his name before My Father and before His messengers.

⁶""The one having an ear, let him hear what the Spirit is saying to the assemblies.""

⁷ "And to the messenger of the assembly in Philadelphia write: 'The holy One, the true One, the One having the key of David, the One opening and no one will shut it except the One opening and no one will open says these things:

⁸ ""I have known your works. Behold: I have given before you a door having been opened, which no one is able to shut; because you are having a little ability, and you guarded My word, and you didn't deny My name. ⁹ Behold: I am giving those of the synagogue of Satan – those saying that they are Jews and are not, but are lying – behold:

I will make them so that they should come and will worship before your feet, and they should know that I was devoted to you. ¹⁰ Because you guarded the word of My endurance, I also will guard you from the hour of testing which is about to come upon the whole inhabited earth, to test those dwelling on the earth.

¹¹ ""I am coming with speed. Be holding fast what you are having, so that no one should take your winner's crown. ¹² The one overcoming, I will make him a pillar in the temple of My God, and he should certainly not exit out any more. And I will write on him the name of My God, and the name of the city of My God: the New Jerusalem, which descends from the heaven from My God, and My new name.

¹³ ""The one having an ear, let him hear what the Spirit is saying to the assemblies."

¹⁴ "And to the messenger of the assembly in Laodicea write: 'The Amen, the Faithful and True Witness, the Beginning of the creation of God is saying these things: ¹⁵ "I have known your works, that you are neither cold nor boiling. Would that you were cold or boiling. ¹⁶ Thus because you are tepid and not boiling or cold, I am about to vomit you out of My mouth. ¹⁷ Because you are saying, 'I am rich and have been rich, and I am having need of nothing,' and haven't known that you are the miserable, and the pitiable, and poor, and blind, and naked, ¹⁸ I am counseling you to buy from Me gold having been fired in fire, so that you should be rich, and white garments so that you should be arrayed, and the shame of your nakedness should not appear, and eyesalve so that you should anoint your eyes so that you should be seeing. ¹⁹ As many as I am loving, I am rebuking and disciplining. Be zealous therefore, and change your mind. ²⁰ Behold: I have stood at the door and am knocking. If anyone should hear My voice and open the door, I also will enter to him and will dine with him and he with Me. ²¹ The one overcoming, I will give to him to sit with Me on My throne, as I also overcame and sat with My Father on His throne.

²² ""The one having an ear, let him hear what the Spirit is saying to the assemblies.""

Revelation 4

¹After these things I looked, and behold: a door having been opened in the heaven, and the first voice which I heard like a trumpet speaking with me saying: "Ascend here, and I will show to you the things which are necessary to happen after these." ² Immediately I became in Spirit, and behold: a throne was set in the heaven and One sitting on the throne, ³ like in appearance to a stone of jasper and sardius, and a rainbow encircling the throne like to the appearance of emerald. ⁴ Encircling the throne were twenty-four thrones, and on the thrones the twenty-four elders sitting, having been arrayed in white robes, and on their heads winner's crowns of gold. ⁵ And from the throne proceed lightnings and voices and thunders. And seven lamps of fire burning before His throne, which are seven spirits of God; ⁶ and before the throne like a glass sea, like to crystal. And in the midst of the throne and encircling the throne, four living beings being full of eyes before and behind. ⁷ And the first living being was like a lion, and the second living being like a calf, and the third living being having the face of a man, and the fourth like a flying eagle. ⁸ And each one of the four living beings, having six wings apiece, are full of eyes around and within. And they aren't having refreshment

day or night, saying, "Holy, holy, holy, holy, holy, holy, holy, holy, holy Lord, the Almighty God, He Who was, and He Who is, and He Who is coming!"

⁹ And whenever the living beings give glory and honor and thanksgiving to He Who is sitting on the throne, to the One living into the ages of the ages, ¹⁰ the twenty-four elders will fall down before the One sitting on the throne and will worship the One living into the ages of the ages, and will throw their winner's crowns before the throne, saying, ¹¹ "You are worthy, O Lord and our God, the Holy One, to receive the glory and the honor and the power, because You created all things, and through Your will they were and were created."

Revelation 5

¹And I saw on the right of the One sitting on the throne a scroll having been written inside and outside, having been tightly sealed with seven seals.

² And I saw a mighty messenger proclaiming with a great voice, "Who is worthy to open the scroll and to loose its seals?" ³ And no one in the heaven above, nor on the earth, nor underneath the earth was able to open the scroll nor to be looking at it. ⁴ And I was wailing much, because no one was found worthy to open the scroll nor to be looking at it.

⁵And one from the elders said to me, "Don't wail. Behold: the Lion from the tribe of Judah, the Root of David overcame, the One opening the scroll and its seven seals." ⁶And I saw in the midst of the throne and of the four living beings, and in the midst of the elders, a Lamb, having stood as having been slain, having seven horns and seven eyes, which are the seven spirits of God being sent forth into all the earth. ⁷And He came, and having taken out of the right hand of the One sitting on the throne. ⁸And when He took the scroll, the four living beings and the twenty-four elders fell before the Lamb, each having a harp and golden bowls being filled with incenses, which are prayers of the holy ones. ⁹And they sing a new song, saying, "You are worthy to take the scroll and to open its seals; because You were slain and bought us to God in Your blood out of every tribe and tongue and people and nation; ¹⁰and You made them kings and priests to our God; and they will reign on the earth."

¹¹ And I looked and heard as a voice of many messengers encircling the throne and the living beings and the elders. And the number of them was ten thousands of ten thousands, and thousands of thousands, ¹² saying with a great voice, "Worthy is the Lamb, the One having been slain, to receive the ability, and the wealth, and wisdom, and might, and honor, and glory, and blessing!"

¹³ And every creature which is in the heaven and on the earth and underneath the earth and on the sea, and all the things in them I heard saying, "To the One sitting on the throne and to the Lamb is the blessing, and the honor, and the glory, and the strength into the ages of the ages. Amen!" - ¹⁴ and the four living beings saying the "Amen." And the elders fell and worshiped.

Revelation 6

¹And I saw that the Lamb opened one of the seven seals. And I heard one of the four living beings speaking like a voice of thunder, "Come and behold." ²And behold: a

white horse and the one sitting on it, having a bow, and a winner's crown was given to him, and he went out conquering and so that he should conquer.

³ And when He opened the second seal, I heard the second living being saying, "Come." ⁴ And another horse – of fire – went out, and to the one sitting on it was given to him to take the peace from the earth, so that they should slay one another; and a great sword was given to him.

⁵ And when He opened the third seal, I heard the third living being saying, "Come and behold." And behold: a black horse, and the one sitting on it, having a yoke in his hand. ⁶ And I heard a voice in the midst of the four living beings, saying, "A choinix of wheat for a denarius, and three choinixes of barley for a denarius; and you may not harm the oil and the wine."

⁷And when He opened the fourth seal, I heard the fourth living being, saying, "Come and behold." ⁸And behold: a green horse and the one sitting upon it whose name was Death, and Hades was following him. And authority was given to him over the fourth of the earth to kill with sword, and with famine, and with death, and under the beasts of the earth.

⁹ And when He opened the fifth seal, I saw underneath the sacrificial altar the souls of those having been slain because of the Word of God and because of the testimony of the Lamb which they were having.

¹⁰ And they cried out with a great voice, saying, "Until when, holy and true Master? Aren't You judging and avenging our blood from those dwelling on the earth?" ¹¹ And a white robe was given to them and they were told that they should rest yet a time, until also the number of their fellow-slaves and their brethren and those about to be killed as also they were should be filled.

¹² And I saw when He opened the sixth seal, and a great earthquake occurred; and the sun became black like sackcloth of hair, and the whole moon became like blood. ¹³ And the stars of the heaven fell to the earth like a fig tree having cast its unripe figs, being shaken by a great wind. ¹⁴ And the heaven was parted like a scroll being rolled up, and every mountain and island were moved out of their places.

¹⁵ And the kings of the earth, and the magistrates, and the chiliarchs, and the rich, and the mighty, and every slave, and every free person hid themselves in the caves and in the rocks of the mountains. ¹⁶ And they said to the mountains and to the rocks, "Fall on us and hide us from the face of the One sitting on the throne and from the wrath of the Lamb! ¹⁷ Because the great day of His wrath has come, and who is able to stand?"

Revelation 7

¹And after this I saw four messengers, having stood at the four corners of the earth, holding the four winds of the earth, so that a wind shouldn't blow on the earth, nor on the sea, nor on any tree. ²And I saw another messenger ascending from the rising of the sun, having a seal of the living God.

And he cried out with a great voice to the four messengers to whom it was given to harm the earth and the sea, ³ saying, "You may not harm the earth, nor the sea, nor the trees until we should seal the slaves of our God on their foreheads. ⁴ And I heard the number of those having been sealed: one hundred and forty-four thousand, having been sealed out of every tribe of the sons of Israel: ⁵ out of the tribe of Judah twelve thousand

having been sealed, out of the tribe of Reuben twelve thousand, out of the tribe of Gad twelve thousand, ⁶ out of the tribe of Asher twelve thousand, out of the tribe of Naphtali twelve thousand, out of the tribe of Manasseh twelve thousand, ⁷ out of the tribe of Simeon twelve thousand, out of the tribe of Levi twelve thousand, out of the tribe of Issachar twelve thousand, ⁸ out of the tribe of Zebulun twelve thousand, out of the tribe of Joseph twelve thousand, out of the tribe of Benjamin twelve thousand, having been sealed.

⁹After these things I saw, and behold: a large crowd which no one was able to number out of all nations and tribes and peoples and tongues, having stood before the throne and before the Lamb, having been arrayed in white robes, and palm branches in their hands. ¹⁰ And they cried out with a great voice, saying, "The salvation belongs to our God: to the One sitting on the throne and to the Lamb!"

¹¹ And all the messengers had stood encircling the throne and the elders and the four living beings, and fell on their faces before His throne, and worshiped God, ¹² saying, "Amen! The blessing, and the glory, and the wisdom and the thanksgiving, and the honor, and the power, and the might belong to our God into the ages of the ages. Amen!"

¹³ And one of the elders answered, saying to me, "These – those having been arrayed in the white robes – who are they, and where did they come from?"

¹⁴ And I said to him, "My lord, you have known."

And he said to me, "These are those coming out of the great affliction, and they cleaned their robes and whitened them in the blood of the Lamb.¹⁵ Because of this they are before the throne of God and minister to Him day and night in His temple. And the One sitting on the throne will dwell over them.¹⁶ They won't hunger any longer, nor will they thirst any longer, nor will the sun by any means fall on them, nor any scorching;¹⁷ because the Lamb Who is upon the midst of the throne is shepherding them, and guiding them to springs of waters of life. And God will blot away every tear from their eyes."

Revelation 8

¹And when He opened the seventh seal, a silence occurred in heaven for about half an hour. ²And I saw the seven messengers who have stood before God, and seven trumpets were given to them.

³ And another messenger came and stood over the sacrificial altar, having a golden frankincense censer, and many incenses were given to him, so that he will give it with the prayers of all the holy ones on the golden sacrificial altar, which is before the throne. ⁴ And the smoke of the incenses ascended with the prayers of the holy ones before God, from the hand of the messenger. ⁵ And the messenger, having taken the censer and filled it from the fire of the sacrificial altar, also threw it to the earth. And thunders, and voices, and lightnings, and an earthquake occurred.

⁶ And the seven messengers – those having the seven trumpets – prepared themselves so that they should sound the trumpets.

⁷ And the first trumpeted, and there occurred hail and fire, having been mixed with blood. And it was thrown to the earth. And the third of the earth was burned up; and the third of the trees was burned up; and all green grass was burned up.

⁸ And the second messenger trumpeted, and something like a great burning mountain was thrown into the sea; and the third of the sea became blood. ⁹ And the third of the creatures in the sea – those having souls – died. And the third of the ships decayed.

¹⁰ And the third messenger trumpeted, and a great star fell out of the heaven, burning like a lamp; and it fell on the third of the rivers and on the springs of waters. ¹¹ And the name of the star is called, "The Wormwood." And the third of the waters turned into wormwood, and many of the men died from the waters, because they were made bitter.

¹² And the fourth messenger trumpeted, and the third of the sun, and the third of the moon, and the third of the stars was struck, so that the third of them should be darkened, and the third of the day shouldn't shine, and the night likewise.

¹³ And I saw and heard one flying eagle, in midheaven, saying with a great voice, "Woe, woe to those dwelling on the earth, from the rest of the trumpet sounds of the three messengers – those being about to trumpet."

Revelation 9

¹And the fifth messenger trumpeted, and I saw a star having fallen out of the heaven to the earth. And the key of the shaft of the depthless place was given to him. 2 And he opened the shaft of the depthless place, and smoke ascended out of the shaft like smoke of a burning furnace. And the sun was darkened, and the air, from the smoke of the shaft. ³ And out of the smoke locusts went out into the earth. And authority was given to them as the scorpions of the earth are having authority. ⁴And it was said to them that they may not harm the grass of the earth, nor any green thing, nor any tree, except the men who aren't having the seal of God on their foreheads. ⁵ And it was given to them so that they shouldn't kill them, but so that they should torture them five months. And their torture was like the torture of a scorpion whenever it strikes a person. ⁶And in those days men will seek death and will certainly not find it; and they will crave to die, and death will flee from them. ⁷ And the appearances of the locusts were like horses having been prepared for war, and on their heads, something like golden winner's crowns, and their faces like faces of men. ⁸ And they were having hair like hair of women, and their teeth were like those of lions. ⁹And they were having breastplates like iron breastplates, and the sound of their wings like the sound of chariots of many horses running into war. ¹⁰ And they are having tails like scorpions, and stings. And in their tails they are having authority toward harming men five months, ¹¹ having a king over them: the messenger of the depthless place, whose name in Hebrew is Abbadon, but in the Greek he is having the name "Destroyer."

¹²The first woe is gone. Behold: yet two woes are coming after these things.

¹³ And the sixth messenger trumpeted. And I heard one voice from the four horns of the golden sacrificial altar which is before God, ¹⁴ saying to the sixth messenger, the one having the trumpet, "Loose the four messengers – those having been bound at the great River Euphrates." ¹⁵ And the four messengers were loosed: those having been prepared for the hour and for the day and month and year, so that they should kill the third of men. ¹⁶ And the number of the troops of the horse was ten thousands of ten thousands. I heard the number of them. ¹⁷ And thus I saw the horses in the vision and

those sitting on them, having breastplates, fiery and hyacinthine and sulfurous. And the heads of the horses were like heads of lions, and out of their mouths go out fire and smoke and sulfur. ¹⁸ Under these three plagues were killed the third of men: from the fire and the smoke and the sulfur which is proceeding out of their mouths. ¹⁹ For the authority of the horses is in their mouth and in their tails; for their tails are like snakes having heads, and with them they are doing harm.

²⁰ And the rest of men – those not killed in these plagues – didn't change their minds from the works of their hands so that they shouldn't worship the demons and the gold and the silver and the bronze and the stone and the wooden idols, which are neither able to see, nor to hear, nor to walk; ²¹ and they didn't change their minds of their murders, nor of their sorcerous drug use, nor of their fornication, nor of their thefts.

Revelation 10

¹And I saw a mighty messenger descending out of the heaven, having been arrayed with a cloud, and the rainbow upon his head, and his face like the sun, and his feet like pillars of fire, ² and having in his hand a scroll having been opened. And he put his right foot on the sea, but the left on the earth. ³And he cried out with a great voice, just like a lion is roaring. And when he cried out, the seven thunders uttered their own voices. ⁴And when the seven thunders spoke, I was about to be writing. And I heard a voice out of the heaven, saying, "Seal up that which the seven thunders spoke, and you may not write them." ⁵And the messenger whom I saw, having stood on the sea and on the earth, lifted up his right hand to the heaven ⁶ and swore by the One living into the ages of the ages, Who created the heaven and the things in it, and the earth and the things in it, and the sea and the things in it, because time will be no longer, ⁷but in the days of the voice of the seventh messenger, when he should be about to be trumpeting, the secret of God is also completed, as He announced as a good message to His slaves, the prophets.

⁸ And the voice which I heard out of the heaven, speaking with me again and saying: "Be going. Take the little scroll – the one having been opened in the hand of the messenger – the one having stood on the sea and on the earth." ⁹ And I went forth toward the messenger, telling him to give to me the little scroll.

And he said to me, "Take and eat it up; and it will make your stomach bitter, but in your mouth it will be sweet like honey." ¹⁰ And I took the scroll out of the hand of the messenger and ate it up, and it was in my mouth sweet like honey. And when I ate it, it made my stomach bitter.

¹¹ And they said to me. "It is necessary for you to prophesy again over many peoples, and over nations, and tongues, and kings."

Revelation 11

¹And a reed like a rod was given to me, saying, "Be rising, and measure the temple of God and the sacrificial altar and those worshipping in it. ²And leave out the outer courtyard of the temple and you may not measure it, because it was given to the nations. And they will tread the holy city forty months and two. ³And I will give to My two witnesses, and they will prophesy one thousand two hundred and sixty days, arrayed in sackcloth."

⁴ These are the two olive trees and the two lampstands which have stood before the Lord of the earth. ⁵ And if anyone is wanting to harm them, fire is proceeding out of their mouths and eats up their enemies. And if anyone is wanting to harm them, thus it is necessary for him to be killed. ⁶ These are having authority to shut the heaven so that it may not rain a rain during the days of their prophecy; and they are having authority over the waters, to be turning them into blood, and to strike the earth as often as they should want with every plague.

⁷ And when they should complete their testimony, the beast – the one ascending out of the depthless place – will make war with them, and overcome them, and kill them. ⁸ And their corpse will lie on the street of the great city which is spiritually called Sodom and Egypt, where also their Lord was crucified. ⁹ And those of the peoples and tribes and tongues and nations are seeing their corpse three-and-a-half days, and they won't allow their corpses to be put in a tomb. ¹⁰ And those dwelling on the earth are rejoicing over them, and will be happy, and will give gifts to one another, because these – the two prophets – tortured those dwelling on the earth. ¹¹ And after the three-and-a-half days, a spirit of life from God entered into them, and they stood on their feet, and great fear fell on those observing them.

¹² And I heard a great voice out of the heaven saying to them, "Ascend here." And they ascended to the heaven in the cloud, and their enemies observed them. ¹³ In that day a great earthquake occurred, and the tenth of the city fell, and seven thousand names of men were killed in the earthquake. And the rest became afraid and gave glory to the God of the heaven.

¹⁴ The second woe passed away. The third woe – behold – is coming with speed.

¹⁵ And the seventh messenger trumpeted, and great voices occurred in the heaven, saying, "The kingdom of the world became that of our Lord and of His Christ, and He will reign into the ages of the ages."

¹⁶ And the twenty-four elders – those before the throne of God, those sitting on their thrones – fell on their faces and worshiped God, ¹⁷ saying, "We are thanking You, Lord God Almighty, He Who is and He Who was, because You have taken Your great power and reigned. ¹⁸ And the nations were angry, and Your anger came, and the season of the dead to be judged, and to give the reward to Your slaves the prophets, and to the holy ones, and to those fearing Your name, to the small and to the great, and to thoroughly corrupt those thoroughly corrupting the earth."

¹⁹ And the temple of God was opened in the heaven, and the ark of the covenant of the Lord was seen in His temple. And lightnings and voices and thunders and great hail occurred.

Revelation 12

¹And a great sign was seen in the heaven: a woman having been arrayed with the sun, and the moon underneath her feet, and on her head a crown of twelve stars. ²And being pregnant, she was crying out, being in birthing pain and being tortured to bear. ³And another sign was seen in the heaven, and behold: a great dragon of fire, having seven heads and ten horns, and on his heads seven crowns. ⁴And his tail dragged a third of the stars of the heaven and threw them to the earth. And the dragon stood before the woman being about to bear, so that when she should bear her Child, he would eat Him

up. ⁵And she bore a Son, a male, Who is about to be shepherding all the nations with an iron rod. And her Child was snatched up to God and to His throne. ⁶And the woman fled into the wilderness where she is having a place there having been prepared by God, so that they should be intensively nourishing her a thousand two hundred and sixty days.

⁷And war took place in the heaven: Michael and his messengers to war with the dragon; and the dragon and his messengers warred; ⁸ and he wasn't mighty, nor was a place yet found for him in the heaven. ⁹And the great dragon was thrown – the ancient snake – the one being called Slanderer and Satan – the one deceiving the whole inhabited earth; he was thrown to the earth, and his messengers were thrown with him.

¹⁰ And I heard a great voice in the heaven, saying, "Now the salvation, and the power, and the kingdom of our God and the authority of His Christ took place, because the accuser of our brethren – the one accusing them before our God day and night – was thrown out. ¹¹ And they overcame him through the blood of the Lamb, and through the word of their testimony, and they weren't devoted to their soul up to death. ¹² Because of this, be happy, heavens, and those dwelling in them! Woe to the earth and to the sea! Because the Slanderer descended to you, having great anger, having known that he is having a brief season."

¹³ And when the dragon saw that he was thrown to the earth, he persecuted the woman that bore the male. ¹⁴ And two wings of the great eagle were given to the woman, so that she should fly into the wilderness, into her place, in order that she should be nourished there a season, and seasons, and half a season, from the face of the snake. ¹⁵ And the snake threw water out of his mouth like a river after the woman, so that he should make her carried away by the river. ¹⁶ And the earth helped the woman, and the earth opened its mouth and drank down the river which the dragon threw out of his mouth. ¹⁷ And the dragon had wrath against the woman, and went off to make war with the rest of her seed: those keeping the commandments of God and having the testimony of Jesus.

Revelation 13

¹And I stood on the sand of the sea. And I saw a beast ascending out of the sea, having ten horns and seven heads, and on its horns ten crowns, and on its heads names of blasphemy. ²And the beast which I saw was like a panther, and its feet like a bear, and its mouth like a mouth of a lion. And the dragon gave to it its power, and its throne, and great authority, ³ and one of its horns as having been slain to death, and the stroke of its death was healed. And the whole earth was amazed after the beast.

⁴And they worshiped the dragon who had given the authority to the beast; and they worshiped the beast, saying, "Who is like the beast? Who is able to war with him?" ⁵And a mouth was given to it, speaking great things and blasphemy, and authority was given to it to make war forty-two months. ⁶And it opened its mouth in blasphemy toward God, to blaspheme His name, and His dwelling: those dwelling in the heaven.

⁷ And it was given to it to make war with the holy ones and to overcome them. And authority was given to it over every tribe, and people, and tongue, and nation. ⁸ And all those residing on the earth will worship him, whose name has not been written from the foundation of the world in the Scroll of Life of the slain Lamb.

⁹ If anyone is having an ear, let him hear.

¹⁰ If anyone is having captivity, he is going.

If anyone is with the sword, it is necessary for him to be killed.

Here is the endurance and the faith of the holy ones.

¹¹ And I saw another beast ascending out of the earth, and it was having two horns like a lamb, and was speaking like a dragon. ¹² And it exercises all the authority of the first beast before it, and it was making the earth and those residing in it that they should worship the first beast, whose stroke of death was healed. ¹³ And it is doing great signs, so that fire also should be coming down out of the heaven onto the earth before the people. ¹⁴ And it is deceiving those of mine who are residing on the earth through the signs which were given to it to do before the beast, saying to those residing on the earth to make an image to the beast who was having the stroke from the sword, and lived. ¹⁵ And it was given to it to give breath to the image of the beast, so that the image of the beast should both speak and make as many as wouldn't worship the image of the beast to be killed. ¹⁶ And it makes all, the small and the great, and the rich and the poor, and the free and the slaves, so that they should give to them imprints on their right hand and on their forehead, ¹⁷ even so that not anyone should be able to buy or to sell, except for he who has the imprint: the name of the beast or the number of its name. ¹⁸ Here is the wisdom: the one having understanding, let him count the number of the beast, for it is a number of a man: his number 666.

Revelation 14

¹And I saw and behold: the Lamb stood on the Mount Zion, and with Him a number – one hundred and forty-four thousand – having His name and the name of His Father having been written on their foreheads. ²And I heard a voice out of the heaven like a voice of many waters and like a voice of great thunder. And the voice which I heard was like harpists harping with their harps. ³And they are singing a new song before the throne and before the four living beings and the elders; and no one was able to learn the song except the one hundred and forty-four thousand who were bought from the earth. ⁴These are those not besmirtched with women, for they are virgins. These are those following the Lamb wherever He should go. These were bought by Jesus from men, firstfruits to God and to the Lamb. ⁵And a lie wasn't found in their mouth, for they are blameless.

⁶ And I saw a messenger flying in midheaven, having an everlasting good message to announce as a good message to those sitting on the earth, and on every nation and tribe and tongue and people, ⁷ saying in a great voice, "Fear the Lord and give glory to Him, because the hour of His judgment came; and worship He Who has made the heaven and the earth and the sea and fountains of waters."

⁸ And another, a second messenger, followed, saying, "Babylon the great fell. From the wine of the anger of her fornication she has drunk all the nations."

⁹ And another messenger, a third, followed them, saying with a great voice, "If anyone is worshiping the beast and his image and is receiving an impression on his forehead or on his hand, ¹⁰ he also will drink of the wine of the anger of God, that having been mixed unmixed in the cup of His wrath. And he will be tortured in fire and sulfur before the holy messengers and before the Lamb. ¹¹ And the smoke of their torture is ascending into the ages of the ages; and they aren't having rest day and night, those

worshiping the beast and his image and if anyone is receiving the impression of his name."

¹²Here is the endurance of the holy ones, those keeping the commands of God and the belief of Jesus. ¹³And I heard a voice out of heaven saying, "Write: 'Blessed are the dead, those dying in the Lord from now on,"

"Yes" says the Spirit, "so that they may rest from their toilings; but their works are following with them."

¹⁴ And I saw, and behold: a white cloud, and on the cloud one sitting like a son of man, having on his head a golden winner's crown, and in his hand a sharp sickle.

¹⁵ And another messenger exited out of the temple, crying out with a great voice to the one sitting on the cloud, "Send your sickle and reap, because the hour came to reap, because the harvest of the earth was withered." ¹⁶ And the one sitting on the cloud threw his sickle on the earth, and the earth was reaped.

¹⁷ And another messenger exited out of the temple in the heaven, he also having a sharp sickle.

¹⁸ And another messenger exited out from the sacrificial altar, having authority over the fire. And he called with a great outcry to the one having the sharp sickle, saying, "Send your sharp sickle and gather the bunches of grapes of the vine of the earth, because the grape cluster of the earth was ripe." ¹⁹ And the messenger threw out his sickle to the earth and gathered the vine of the earth and threw it into the winepress of the anger of the great God. ²⁰ And the winepress was trampled outside the city, and blood came out of the winepress up to the bits of the horses from a thousand six hundred stadia.

Revelation 15

¹And I saw another sign in the heaven, great and amazing: seven messengers having the seven last plagues, because in them the anger of God was finished.

² And I saw like a glassy sea, having been mingled with fire, and those overcoming against the beast and against his image and against the number of his name, having stood on the glassy sea, having the harps of God. ³ And they are singing the song of Moses, the slave of God, and the song of the Lamb, saying, "Great and amazing Your works, Lord God the Almighty; righteous and true Your ways, O King of the nations! ⁴ Who shall not indeed fear You, Lord, and glorify Your name? Because You only are holy; because all will come and worship before You; because Your righteous acts were manifested."

⁵ And after these things, I saw, and the temple of the tabernacle of the testimony was opened in heaven. ⁶ And the seven messengers exited, those having the seven plagues, who were clothed in clean bright linen, and having been girded about the chests with golden belts. ⁷ And one of the four living beings gave to the seven messengers seven golden bowls being filled with the anger of God, Who lives into the ages of the ages. ⁸ And the temple was filled with the smoke from the glory of God and from His power. And no one was able to enter into the temple until the seven plagues of the seven messengers should be finished.

Revelation 16

¹And I heard a great voice from the temple saying to the seven messengers, "Be going, and spill out the seven bowls of the anger of God into the earth."

² And the first went forth and spilled out his bowl into the earth, and a bad and infectious sore came on the men having the imprint of the beast and those worshipping his image.

³And the second messenger spilled out his bowl into the sea, and it became blood as of a dead person; and every soul in the sea died.

⁴And the third spilled out his bowl into the rivers and into the fountains of the waters, and it became blood.

⁵ And I heard the messenger of the waters saying, "You are righteous, He Who is and He Who was, holy, because You judged these things. ⁶Because they spilled out blood of holy ones and prophets, You also gave blood to them to drink. They are deserving."

⁷ And I heard the sacrificial altar saying, "Yes, Lord God the Almighty, true and righteous Your judgments!"

⁸ And the fourth spilled out his bowl on the sun, and it was given to him to scorch men in fire. ⁹ And the men were scorched with a great scorching. And men blasphemed the name of God Who is having authority over these plagues. And they didn't change their minds to give glory to Him.

¹⁰ And the fifth spilled out his bowl on the throne of the beast, and his kingdom became darkened; and they chewed their tongues from their pain. ¹¹ And they blasphemed the God of heaven because of their pains and because of their sores. And they didn't change their minds from their works.

¹² And the sixth spilled out his bowl on the great river Euphrates, and its water was dried up, so that the way should be prepared for the kings – those from the rising of the sun. ¹³ And I saw three unclean spirits like frogs out of the mouth of the dragon, and out of the mouth of the beast, and out of the mouth of the false prophet. ¹⁴ For they are spirits of demons doing signs, which are going out on the kings of the whole inhabited earth, to gather them to the war of that great day of the Almighty God.

¹⁵ "Behold: I am coming like a thief. Blessed is the one watching and keeping his garments, so that he shouldn't be walking naked and they shouldn't be seeing his shame."

¹⁶ And he gathered them to the place being called in Hebrew Megiddo.

¹⁷ And the seventh spilled out his bowl on the air, and a great voice came out from the temple of the heaven, from the throne, saying, "It has occurred!" ¹⁸ And lightnings and thunders and voices and a great earthquake occurred, such as didn't occur from when men came on the earth, so great an earthquake, so great. ¹⁹ And the great city became divided into three parts, and the cities of the nations fell. And Babylon the great was remembered before God, to give to her the cup of the wine of the anger of His wrath. ²⁰ And every island fled, and mountains were not found. ²¹ And great hail about a talentweight came down out of the heaven on men. And men blasphemed God because of the plague of the hail, because this plague is extremely great.

Revelation 17

¹And one of the seven messengers having the seven bowls came and spoke with me, saying, "Here, I will show to you the judgment of the great fornicatress – the one sitting on the many waters, ² with whom the kings of the earth fornicated – and those dwelling on the earth were drunk from the wine of her fornication." ³And he carried me away in spirit into a wilderness. And I saw a woman sitting on a scarlet beast, being filled with names of blasphemy, having seven heads and ten horns. ⁴And the woman was arrayed in purple and scarlet, having been gilded with gold and precious stones and pearls, having a golden cup in her hand being filled with abominations and the unclean things of the fornication of the earth, ⁵and on her forehead a name written: SECRET BABYLON THE GREAT, THE MOTHER OF THE FORNICATRESSES AND OF THE ABOMINATIONS OF THE EARTH. ⁶And I saw the woman being drunk from the blood of the holy ones, from the blood of the witnesses of Jesus. And having seen her, I was amazed with great amazement.

⁷And the messenger said to me, "For what are you amazed? I will tell to you the secret of the woman and of the beast carrying her, of the one having the seven heads and the ten horns. ⁸The beast which you saw was, and isn't, and is about to be ascending out of the depthless place and to be going to destruction. And those dwelling on the earth will be amazed, whose name hasn't been written on the scroll of life from the foundation of the world, seeing that the beast was, and isn't, and will be present.

⁹ "Here is the mind, the one having wisdom: The seven heads are seven mountains where the woman is sitting on them. ¹⁰ And there are seven kings. The five fell, the one is, the other came not yet. And when he comes, it is necessary for him to continue a little. ¹¹ And the beast which was, and isn't, also this one is an eighth, and is of the seven, and he is going into destruction. ¹² And the ten horns which you saw are ten kings, who not yet received a kingdom, but are receiving authority as kings for one hour with the beast. ¹³ These are having one counsel, and their power and authority they are giving to the beast. ¹⁴ These will war with the Lamb, and the Lamb will overcome them, because He is Lord of lords and King of kings; and those with Him, called, and chosen, and faithful."

¹⁵ And he said to me, "The waters which you saw, where the fornicatress is sitting are peoples and crowds and nations and tongues. ¹⁶ And the ten horns which you saw and the beast, these will hate the fornicatress and will have made her desolate, and will make her naked, and will eat her flesh, and will burn her up in fire. ¹⁷ For God gave into their hearts to do His counsel, and to make them one counsel, and to give their kingdom to the beast until the words of God should be fulfilled. ¹⁸ And the woman whom you saw is the great city, the one having kingship over the kings on the earth."

Revelation 18

¹After these things I saw another messenger descending out of the heaven, having great authority, and the earth was illuminated from his glory. ²And he cried out with a mighty voice, saying, "Babylon the great fell, and became a habitation of demons and a prison of every unclean spirit, and a prison of every unclean and hated fowl. ³Because all the nations have drunk from the wine of the wrath of her fornication, and the kings of the

earth fornicated with her, and the merchants of the earth became rich from the ability of her arrogant sensuality."

⁴And I heard another voice out of the heaven, saying, "Go out out of her, My people, so that you should not participate with her sins, and so that you should not receive of her plagues. ⁵Because her sins reached up to the heaven, and God remembered of her – her injustices. ⁶Render to her as she also rendered, and double the doubles, as also she, and according to her works; in her cup which she mixed mix double. ⁷As much as she glorified herself and lived in aggressive sensuality, by so much give her torture and mourning; because in her heart she says, 'I am sitting, a queen, and I am not a widow, and I shall certainly not see mourning.' ⁸Because of this, in one day her plagues will come: death, mourning, and famine. And she will be burned up in fire, because mighty is the Lord God having judged her.

⁹ "And the kings of the earth – those having fornicated and lived in aggressive sensuality with her – will wail and grieve over her when they see the smoke of her burning, ¹⁰ having stood from afar because of the fear of her torture, saying, 'Woe, woe, the great city Babylon, the mighty city! Because in one hour your judgment came.'

¹¹ "And the merchants of the earth will wail and mourn over her, because no one is buying their cargo anymore: ¹² cargo of gold, and silver, and precious stone, and pearls, and goods of bussos-cloth, and purple, and silk, and scarlet, and all thyine wood, and every ivory vessel, and every vessel of most precious wood, and bronze, and iron, and marble, ¹³ and cinnamon, and incense, and myrrh, and frankincense, and wine, and olive oil, and fine flour, and wheat, and sheep, and creatures, and of horses, and of fourwheeled vehicles, and of bodies and souls of men. ¹⁴ And the ripe fruit of the craving of your soul went forth from you, and all the affluent and bright things perished from you, and you shall certainly not find them anymore. ¹⁵ The merchants of these things – those having become rich from her – will stand from afar because of the fear of her torture, both wailing and mourning, ¹⁶ and saying, 'Woe, woe, the great city – the one having been arrayed in bussos-cloth, and purple, and scarlet, and having been gilded with gold and precious stone and pearls! ¹⁷Because in one hour such great riches were made desolate.'

"And every steersman, and everyone sailing upon a place, and mariners, and as many as are working the sea, stood from afar, ¹⁸ and were crying out, seeing the smoke of her burning, saying, 'Who is like the great city?' ¹⁹ And they threw dirt on their heads and were crying out, wailing, and mourning, and saying, 'Woe, woe, the great city by which all those having the boats in the sea became rich from her costliness! Because in one hour she was made desolate. ²⁰ Be happy over her, heaven, and the holy ones, and the apostles, and the prophets, because God judged your judgment against her!""

²¹ And one mighty messenger picked up a stone like a great millstone of a donkey and threw it into the sea, saying, "Thus with onslaught Babylon the great city will be thrown, and she will certainly not be found anymore. ²² And the sound of harpists and musicians and flutists and trumpeters shall certainly not be heard in you anymore. And every craftsman of every craft shall certainly not be found in you anymore. And the sound of a millstone of a donkey shall certainly not be heard in you anymore. ²³ And a light of a lamp shall certainly not shine in you anymore. And a voice of a bridegroom and a bride shall certainly not be heard in you merchants were the magnates of the earth, because by your sorcerous drug use all the nations were deceived. ²⁴ And in her was found the blood of prophets and holy ones and of all those having been slain on the earth."

Revelation 19

¹After these things I heard like a great voice of a large crowd in the heaven, saying, "Hallelujah! The salvation and the power and the glory of our God! ²Because true and righteous are His judgments, because He judged the great fornicatress who thoroughly corrupted the earth in her fornication, and He avenged the blood of His slaves from her hand."

³And a second had said, "Hallelujah. And her smoke is ascending into the ages of the ages!"

⁴And the twenty-four elders and the four living beings fell down and worshiped God Who is sitting on the throne, saying, "Amen. Hallelujah!"

⁵ And a voice came out from the throne, saying, "Praise our God, all His slaves and those fearing Him, the small and the great!"

⁶ And I heard like a voice of a large crowd and like a voice of many waters and like the sound of mighty thunders, saying, "Hallelujah, because the Lord our God the Almighty reigned! ⁷ We should be rejoicing and being glad and giving the glory to Him, because the wedding of the Lamb came and His wife prepared herself. ⁸ And it was given to her that she should be arrayed in bright and clean bussos cloth, for the bussos cloth is the righteous acts of the holy ones."

⁹ And he said to me, "Write: 'Blessed are those having been called to the dinner of the wedding of the Lamb.'" And he said to me, "These are the true words of God." ¹⁰ And I fell before his feet to worship him. And he said to me, "Don't see yourself to do that! I am a fellow slave of yours and of your brethren who have the testimony of Jesus. Worship God. For the testimony of Jesus is the spirit of the prophecy."

¹¹ And I saw the heaven having been opened, and behold: a white horse, and the One sitting on it being called Faithful and True, and in righteousness He is judging and warring. ¹² But His eyes were a flame of fire, and on His head many crowns, having names written, and a name having been written which no one has known except He, ¹³ and having been arrayed in a garment having been immersed in blood, and His name has been called "The Word of God." ¹⁴ And the armies – those in the heaven – were following Him on white horses, having been clothed in white clean bussos cloth. ¹⁵ And from His mouth goes out a sharp double-mouthed sword, so that with it He should strike the nations. And He will shepherd them with an iron rod. And He treads the winepress of the wine of the anger of the wrath of Almighty God. ¹⁶ And He is having on His garment and on His thigh a name having been written: KING OF KINGS AND LORD OF LORDS.

¹⁷ And I saw a messenger having stood in the sun; and he cried out with a great voice, saying to all the flying fowl in midheaven, "Come. Gather for the great dinner of God, ¹⁸ so that you should eat flesh of kings, and flesh of chiliarchs, and flesh of the mighty, and flesh of horses and those sitting on them, and flesh of all, both free and slaves, and both small and great."

¹⁹ And I saw the beast and the kings of the earth and their armies, having been gathered to make the war with the One having sat on the horse and with His army. ²⁰ And

the beast was captured and the false prophet with him, the one having done the signs before him by which he deceived those having received the impression of the beast and those worshiping his image. The two were thrown alive into the lake of fire which is burning with sulfur. ²¹ And the rest were killed with the sword of the One sitting on the horse, which is having exited out from His mouth. And all the fowl were filled from their flesh.

Revelation 20

¹And I saw a messenger descending out of the heaven, having the key to the depthless place and a great chain in his hand. ²And he seized the dragon, the ancient snake who is a slanderer and Satan, the one deceiving the whole inhabited earth, and he bound him a thousand years. ³And he threw him into the depthless place and closed and sealed it over him so that he should be deceiving the nations no more until the thousand years should be completed. After these things it is necessary for him to be loosed for a little time.

⁴ And I saw thrones, and they sat on them, and judgment was given to them, and the souls of those having been axed because of the testimony of Jesus and because of the Word of God and who didn't worship the beast nor his image and didn't receive the impression on their forehead and on their hand. And they lived and reigned with the Christ for the thousand years. ⁵ And the rest of the dead didn't live until the thousand years should be completed. This is the first resurrection.

⁶Blessed and holy is he having a part in the first resurrection. Over these the second death isn't having power, but they will be priests of God and of the Christ, and will reign with Him a thousand years.

⁷ And after the thousand years, Satan will be loosed out of his prison ⁸ and will go out to deceive the nations which are in the four corners of the earth, Gog and Magog, to gather them to the war, of whom the number of them is like the sand of the sea. ⁹ And they ascended on the breadth of the earth and encircled the encampment of the holy ones and the beloved city. And fire descended out of the heaven from God and devoured them. ¹⁰ And the slanderer who is deceiving them was thrown into the lake of fire and sulfur, where also the beast and the false prophet are. And they will be tortured day and night into the ages.

¹¹ And I saw a great white throne and the One sitting on it, from Whose face the earth and the heaven fled. And a place wasn't found for them. ¹² And I saw the dead, the great and the small, having stood before the throne, and they opened scrolls. And another scroll was opened, which is of life. And the dead were judged out of the things having been written in the scrolls, according to their works. ¹³ And the sea gave up the dead who were in it. And death and Hades gave up the dead who were in them. And they were judged, each one according to their works. ¹⁴ And death and Hades were thrown into the lake of fire. This is the second death: the lake of fire. ¹⁵ And if anyone wasn't found having been written in the Scroll of life, he was thrown into the lake of fire.

Revelation 21

¹And I saw a new heaven and a new earth; and the first heaven and the first earth went away. And the sea is not any longer. ²And I saw the holy city, New Jerusalem, descending out of the heaven from God, having been prepared like a bride having been adorned for her husband.

³ And I heard a great voice out of the heaven saying, "Behold: the tabernacle of God with men, and He will tabernacle with them, and they will be His people, and God Himself will be with them. ⁴ And He will blot away from them every tear from their eyes, and death will not be any longer, nor mourning, nor outcry, nor pain will be any longer, because the first things went away."

⁵ And the One sitting on the throne said, "Behold: I am making all things new." And He said, "Write, because these words are faithful and true – the words of God." ⁶ And He said to me, "I have become the Alpha and the Omega, and the Beginning and the Completion. I, to the one thirsting will give to him from the fountain of the water of the life freely. ⁷ The one overcoming, I will give to him these things, and I will be God to him, and he will be a son to Me. ⁸ But to the cowardly, and unbelieving, and sinners, and abominable, and murderers, and fornicators, and sorcerous drug users, and idolaters, and all the false, their part is in the lake burning with fire and sulfur, which is the second death."

⁹And one of the seven messengers having the seven bowls full of the seven last plagues came and spoke with me, saying, "Come. I will show to you the wife, the bride of the Lamb." ¹⁰ And he carried me away in spirit onto a great and high mountain, and showed me the holy city Jerusalem, descending out of the heaven from God, ¹¹ having the glory of God, its radiance similar to a most precious stone, like a jasper stone, resembling crystal, ¹² having a great and high wall, having twelve gateways, and at the gateways twelve messengers, and names having been inscribed which are names of the twelve tribes of the sons of Israel; ¹³ from the sunrising three gateways, and from the north wind three gateways, and from the south three gateways, and from the sunsetting three gateways, ¹⁴ and the wall of the city having twelve foundations, and on them twelve names of the twelve apostles of the Lamb. ¹⁵ And the one speaking with me had a measure, a golden reed, so that he should measure the city and its gateways and its wall. ¹⁶ And the city is lying four-cornered, and its length as great as the breadth. And he measured the city with the reed at twelve thousand and twelve stadia. The length and the breadth and the height of it are equal. ¹⁷ And its wall a hundred and forty-four forearms by measure of a man, which is of a messenger. ¹⁸ And the structure of its wall was jasper, and the city pure gold, like pure glass, ¹⁹ the foundations of the wall of the city having been adorned with every precious stone; the first foundation jasper, the second sapphire, the third chalcedony, the fourth emerald, ²⁰ the fifth sardonyx, the sixth sardius, the seventh goldenstone, the eighth beryl, the ninth topaz, the tenth goldenleek, the eleventh hyacinth, the twelfth amethyst.

²¹ And the twelve gateways are twelve pearls, again, each one of the gateways was from one pearl, and the street of the city pure gold, like transparent glass.

²² And I didn't see a temple in it, for the Lord God the Almighty is its temple – also the Lamb. ²³ And the city hasn't need of the sun nor the moon so that they may be shining in it, for the glory of God illuminated it, and its lamp is the Lamb. ²⁴ And the nations will walk by its light, and the kings of the earth will carry to it the glory and honor of the nations into it.

²⁵ And its gateways will certainly not be closed by day (for night won't be there).
²⁶ And they will carry the glory and the honor of the nations into it so that they may enter.
²⁷ And anything common, and the one doing an abomination and lie may certainly not enter into it, but only those having been written in the Scroll of Life of the Lamb.

Revelation 22

¹And he showed me a river of water of life, bright as crystal, proceeding from the throne of God and of the Lamb. ²In the midst of its street and of the river, from here and from there, a tree of life, producing twelve fruits, each rendering its fruit monthly, and the leaves of the tree for healing of the nations. ³And every curse will be no longer, and the throne of God and of the Lamb will be in it, and His slaves are ministering to Him. ⁴And they will see His face, and His name on their foreheads. ⁵And there will be no night, and no need of a lamp and light, because the Lord God will enlighten them. And they will reign into the ages.

⁶ And he said to me, "These words are faithful and true. And the Lord God of the spirits of the prophets sent forth His messenger to show His slaves the things needing to happen in speed."

⁷ "And behold: I am coming with speed. Blessed is the one keeping the words of the prophecy of this scroll."

⁸ And I, John, am the one hearing and seeing these things. And when I heard and when I saw, I fell down to worship before the feet of the messenger showing these things to me.

⁹And he said to me, "Don't see yourself to do that! I am a fellow-slave of yours and of your brethren the prophets and of those keeping the words of this scroll. Worship God."

¹⁰ And he said to me, "You may not seal the words of the prophecy of this scroll, for the season is near. ¹¹ The one acting unjustly, let him act unjustly still; and the one filthy, let him be filthy still; and the righteous, let him do righteousness still; and the holy, let him be holy still."

¹² "Behold: I am coming with speed, and My wages are with Me, to render to each as his work is. ¹³ I am the Alpha and the Omega, the First and the Last, the Beginning and the Completion."

¹⁴Blessed are those doing His commands, so that theirs may be the authority to the tree of life and so that they may enter by the gateways into the city. ¹⁵Outside are the dogs, and the sorcerous drug users, and the fornicators, and the murderers, and the idolaters, and everyone loving and telling a lie.

¹⁶ "I, Jesus, sent My messenger to testify these things to you over the assemblies. I am the Root and Kindred of David, the Bright Morning Star.

¹⁷ "And the Spirit and the bride are saying, 'Come.' And let the one hearing say, 'Come.' And let the one thirsting come. The one wanting to, let him take water of life freely.

¹⁸ "I am testifying to everyone hearing the words of the prophecy of this scroll, if anyone should add to them, may God add onto him the plagues – those having been written in this scroll. ¹⁹ And if anyone should take away from the words of the scroll of this prophecy, God might take away his part from the tree of life and from the holy city – those things having been written in this scroll.

²⁰ "The One testifying these things is saying, 'Yes, I am coming with speed.'" Amen! Yes! Come, Lord Jesus!

²¹ The grace of the Lord Jesus Christ is with all the holy ones. Amen.
