

Psalm 101

Of David. A psalm.

¹Let me sing lovingkindness and judgment to You, Yahweh. Let me carol!

²Let me be insightful in an unimpaired way. At what extent will You enter to me? I will cause to walk in my heart's integrity in the midst of my house.

³I'm not setting before my eyes a thing of worthlessness. To do deviations I have hated. It won't cling inside me.

⁴A warped heart will turn aside from me. I'm not knowing evil.

⁵One maligning his neighbor in concealment, he himself I will ravage. He of high eyes and smugly prevailing heart, he himself I can't stand.

⁶My eyes are on those of the land who are being made sure, so as to dwell with me. One walking in an unimpaired way, he will minister to me.

⁷He doing defrauding won't dwell in the midst of my house. One speaking deceptions won't be established before my eyes.

⁸In the mornings I will ravage all wicked of the land, to cut from the city of Yahweh all those preparing iniquity.

Psalm 102

A prayer of the humble when he is feeble and pours out his reflection to Yahweh.

¹Yahweh, hear my prayer, and my pleading will enter to You.

²You aren't causing Your face to be concealed from me in a day of my adversity. Cause Your ear to be stretched out to me. In a day I call, hurry! Answer me.

³Because in smoke my days were finished, and my bones were charred like an incinerator.

⁴My heart has been stricken and dried up like vegetation, because I have forgotten to eat my bread.

⁵From a voice of my sighing my bone has clung to my flesh.

⁶I have been likened to a pelican of a wilderness. I have become like a night-raven of dry places.

⁷I have been vigilant, and I have been like a fowl being alone on a roof.

⁸All the day my enemies have intensely reproached me. Those being mad against me were made to swear.

⁹Because I have eaten ashes like bread, and my drink I have mingled with weeping,

¹⁰from the face of Your rage and irateness, because You have lifted me and cast me.

¹¹My days are like a shade being stretched out, and I am dry like vegetation.

¹²But You, Yahweh, sit to everlasting, and Your remembrance is to generation and generation.

¹³You will arise. You have compassion on Zion, because a time to be benevolent to her, because an appointed time has entered.

¹⁴When Your servants were well-pleased with its stones, and its dust was shown benevolence.

¹⁵And nations will fear the name of Yahweh, and all the kings of the earth Your glory.
¹⁶When Yahweh builds Zion, He has been seen in His glory.
¹⁷He has turned toward a prayer of the denuded, and hasn't disesteemed their prayer.
¹⁸This will be written for a generation after, and a people being created will praise Yah.
¹⁹Because He observed from the height of His holiness; Yahweh looked from the heavens
to the earth,
²⁰to hear the moaning of a prisoner, to open up sons of dying,
²¹to recount in Zion the name of Yahweh, and His praise in Jerusalem,
²²in the amassing of peoples and kingdoms together to serve Yahweh.
²³He humiliated my vitality in the way. He has shortened my days.
²⁴I say, "My God, don't cause to go up in the half of my days, in a generation of generations
Your years.
²⁵Before things You founded the earth, and heavens are an occupation of Your hands.
²⁶They will perish, but You will stand; and they all like a garment will wear out. Like clothing
You will cause them to be overturned, and they will be overturned.
²⁷But You are He; and Your years won't fail.
²⁸Sons of Your servants will settle, and their seed will be established before You.

Psalm 103

Of David.

¹Bless Yahweh, my soul; and all within me the name of His holiness.
²Bless Yahweh, my soul, and you shall not forget all His dealings:
³forgiving all my perversity, healing all my maladies,
⁴redeeming my life from corruption, crowning me with lovingkindness and cherishing,
⁵satisfying your ornament with good. My youth intensely renews itself like the eagle,
⁶Yahweh doing righteousnesses and judgments for all those being oppressed.
⁷He makes known His ways to Moses, His practices to the sons of Israel,
⁸cherishing and benevolent Yahweh, slow of angers and abundant of lovingkindness,
⁹He won't strive to perpetuity, nor guard offense to everlastings.
¹⁰He hasn't done toward us according to our sins, nor dealt with us according to our
perversities.
¹¹Because as high as heavens above the earth, His lovingkindness has been mighty over
those fearing Him.
¹²As distant is sunrising from westward, He has caused our rebellions to be distant from
us.
¹³Like a father to intensely cherish sons, Yahweh has intensely cherished those fearing
Him.
¹⁴Because He has known our formation, being made to remember that we are dust.
¹⁵Man is as grass, his days as a blossom of the field; thus he blossoms.
¹⁶Because wind passed against it, and it is not, and its place won't yet recognize it.
¹⁷But the lovingkindness of Yahweh is from everlasting and until everlasting upon those
fearing Him, and His righteousness to sons of sons,

¹⁸to those keeping His covenant and remembering His overseeing mandates to do them.
¹⁹Yahweh has established His throne in the heavens, and His reign has ruled in everything.
²⁰Bless Yahweh, His messengers, mighty of vitality, doing His word, to listen at a voice of His word.
²¹Bless Yahweh, all His armies, His ministers doing His good pleasure.
²²Bless Yahweh, all His occupations, in all places of His rule.
Bless Yahweh, my soul!

Psalm 104

¹Bless Yahweh, my soul. Yahweh my God, You are very great. You have been clothed with dignity and splendor,
²being cloaked with light as a robe, stretching out the heavens like a curtain,
³laying beams in the waters, His upper rooms, placing nimbus clouds for His chariot, always walking over wings of the wind,
⁴making His messengers spirits, and His ministers flaming fire.
⁵He has founded earth on its base; it won't be rocked forever and ever.
⁶You have covered up a raging mass of water as clothing; over mountains stand waters.
⁷From Your rebuke they flee. From a sound of Your convulsion they are precipitate.
⁸Mountains go up, flatlands go down to a place, this place You have founded for them.
⁹You have set a border that they don't pass; they won't return to cover up the earth,
¹⁰You, the One sending out springs into brooks; between mountains they go.
¹¹They water every living being of the field; wild donkeys break their thirst.
¹²Over them a bird of the heavens settles; from between foliage they give voice.
¹³The One watering mountains from His upper rooms, from the fruit of Your occupations the earth is satisfied,
¹⁴causing grass to grow for the animal, and vegetation for the service of man, to bring out bread from the earth.
¹⁵... and wine makes the heart of man thoroughly rejoice, to cause his face to glow.
From oil and bread He sustains the heart of man.
¹⁶Trees of Yahweh are satisfied; cedars of Lebanon He has planted,
¹⁷wherein fowl nest. The stork has cypresses for its house,
¹⁸high mountains for the ibexes, crags a refuge for hyraxes.
¹⁹He made lunation for appointed times; sun has known its entrance.
²⁰You set darkness and let it be night. In it all the living things of a forest crawl.
²¹The adolescent lions are roaring for prey and to seek from God their food.
²²The sun rises. They are gathered, and to their habitations they lie down.
²³Man exits to his preparation, and to his service until evening.
²⁴How Your occupations have abounded, Yahweh! You have made all of them in wisdom.
The earth has been filled with Your gain.
²⁵This is the great sea, and wide at both hands; there is the crawling thing and there is no counting, living things, small with great.
²⁶There ships always go. Leviathan: this You formed to play in it.
²⁷All of them are in anticipation toward You to give their food in its time.

²⁸You give to them; they gather. You open Your hand; they are satisfied with good.
²⁹You conceal Your face; they are anxious.
You gather their breath; they expire, and to their dust they return.
³⁰You send forth Your Spirit; they are created, and You renew the face of the ground.
³¹May the glory of Yahweh be to everlasting. Yahweh will rejoice in His occupations,
³²looking at the earth and it will shudder. He will touch at the mountains, and they will smoke.
³³Let me sing to Yahweh in my life; let me carol to my God in my still being here.
³⁴My reflection upon Him is enjoyable. I rejoice in Yahweh.
³⁵Sinners are brought to an end from the land; and wicked ones, there are none of them still. Bless Yahweh, my soul. Praise Yah.

Psalm 105

¹Confess to Yahweh. Call on His name. Make known among the peoples His practices.
²Sing to Him. Carol to Him. Voice reflections on all His extraordinaries.
³Ever boast in the name of His holiness. The heart of those seeking Yahweh will rejoice.
⁴Seek out Yahweh and His strength. Seek His face continually.
⁵Remember His extraordinaries which He has done, His portents and judgments of His mouth,
⁶seed of Abraham His servant, sons of Jacob His chosen.
⁷He is Yahweh our God. In all the earth are His judgments.
⁸He has remembered to everlasting His covenant, a word He commanded to a thousand generations,
⁹which He cut with Abraham, and His oath to Isaac,
¹⁰and it was caused to stand for Jacob for legislation, an everlasting covenant for Israel,
¹¹to say, "To you I will give the land of Canaan as a line of your inheritance,"
¹²in their being a man of counting, a little, and sojourners in it.
¹³And they kept going from nation to nation, from a kingdom to another people.
¹⁴He didn't cause man to settle, to oppress them, but He reproved kings over them:
¹⁵"Don't touch at My annointed, and you won't cause evil to My prophets."
¹⁶And He called a famine on the earth. He broke every staff of bread.
¹⁷He sent a man before them; for a servant Joseph was sold.
¹⁸His feet were humiliated in fetters. Iron entered His soul.
¹⁹Until the time for His word to enter, a saying of Yahweh refined him.
²⁰A king sent and let him loose, a ruler of peoples, and he ungirded him.
²¹He placed him as lord for his house and ruler among all his gain,
²²to bind his authorities with his soul, and to make his elders utterly wise.
²³And Israel entered Egypt, and Jacob sojourned in the land of Ham.
²⁴And He caused His people to bear fruit very much, and He caused him to be more powerful than his adversaries.
²⁵He turned their heart to hate His people, to act deviously with His servants.
²⁶He sent Moses His servant, Aaron whom He had chosen in Him.
²⁷They placed among them words of His signs, and portents in the land of Ham.

²⁸He sent darkness and caused it to be dark, and they didn't defy His word.
²⁹He turned their waters to blood, and put their fish to death.
³⁰Their land teemed with frogs in rooms of their kings.
³¹He spoke, and swarms entered, gnats in all their border.
³²He gave their rainfall hail, fire of flames in the land.
³³And He struck their vine and their fig trees, and utterly broke trees of their border.
³⁴He spoke, and the locust entered, and lapper-insect with no counting,
³⁵and they ate all the vegetation in their land, and they ate the fruit of the ground.
³⁶And He struck all firstborn in their land, a beginning to all their virility.
³⁷And He caused them to exit with silver and gold, and there was no stumbling within His branches.
³⁸Egypt rejoiced in their exiting, because their startling had fallen upon them.
³⁹He spread out a cloud for a protective covering, and fire to cause to light night.
⁴⁰He asked, and He caused quail to enter, and He was causing bread of heavens to satisfy them.
⁴¹He opened a rock, and waters flowed. They went, a river, into the aridities.
⁴²Because He remembered a word of His holiness with Abraham His servant.
⁴³And He caused His people to exit with happiness, His chosen with cheering.
⁴⁴And He gave to them lands of nations, and they possess toil of countries,
⁴⁵for the sake of their keeping His legislations and guarding His doctrines. Praise Yah!

Psalm 106

¹Praise Yah ! Confess Yahweh because He is good, to everlasting His lovingkindness.
²Who will thoroughly discourse on the mights of Yahweh, making all His praise?
³O, the happinesses of those keeping judgment, doing righteousness in every time.
⁴Remember me, Yahweh, in the goodpleasure of Your people. Oversee me in Your salvation,
⁵to see the goodness of Your chosen, to rejoice in a rejoicing of Your nation, to boast with Your inheritance.
⁶We have sinned with our fathers. We have caused others to be perverse. We have caused others to be wicked.
⁷Our fathers in Egypt weren't insightful into Your extraordinaries. They didn't remember Your lovingkindnesses, and caused defiance at a sea, in the Sea of Waterweed.
⁸And He saved them for His name's sake, to make His might known,
⁹and He rebuked at the Sea of Waterweed, and it dried, and He caused them to walk in the raging mass of water as in the wilderness.
¹⁰And He saved them from the one hating, and redeemed them from the hand of the enemy,
¹¹and waters covered up their adversaries; not one of them was left.
¹²And they believed His words. They sang His praise.
¹³They hurried. They forgot His occupations. They didn't intensely wait for His counsel.
¹⁴And they always longed a longing in the wilderness, and they tried God in a desolation.
¹⁵And He gave to them their request, and sent forth emaciation into their soul.

¹⁶And they were jealous toward Moses in the camp, toward Aaron, holy one of Yahweh.
¹⁷The earth opens and swallows Dathan, and covers up over the congregation of Abiram!
¹⁸And a fire burned in their congregation; a flame intensely flamed wicked ones.
¹⁹They were making a calf in Horeb, and were worshipping toward a depiction.
²⁰And they were changing their glory into a pattern of a bull eating vegetation.
²¹They forgot God their Savior, the One doing great things in Egypt,
²²extraordinaries in a land of Ham, things being feared upon the Sea of Waterweed.
²³And He said to extirpate them, except Moses, His chosen, stood in a bursting forth before Him, to cause His fury to return from causing them to corrupt.
²⁴And they rejected in a land of desire. They didn't believe toward his word.
²⁵And they murmured in their tents. They didn't listen to the voice of Yahweh.
²⁶And He lifted His hand toward them, to cause them to fall in the wilderness,
²⁷and to cause their seed to fall among the nations, and to strew them in the lands.
²⁸And they were coupled to Baal of Peor, and ate sacrifices of dead ones.
²⁹And they caused vexation with their praxes, and a scourge burst forth among them.
³⁰And Phinehas stood and arbitrated, and the scourge was restrained.
³¹And it was counted to him for righteousness to generation and generation until everlasting.
³²And they caused irateness over the waters of Conflict, and it was evil for Moses for their sakes,
³³because they caused his spirit to be defiant, and he utterly spoke carelessly with his lips.
³⁴They didn't extirpate the peoples, as Yahweh had said to them,
³⁵and admixed themselves among the nations, and learned their occupations,
³⁶and they served their idols, and they were for a trap for them.
³⁷And they sacrificed their sons and their daughters to demons,
³⁸and they poured out innocent blood, blood of their sons and their daughters whom they kept sacrificing to the idols of Canaan, and the land was polluted with blood.
³⁹And they were defiled in their occupations, and fornicated in their praxes.
⁴⁰And the anger of Yahweh fumed against His people, and He abominated His inheritance.
⁴¹And He gave them into the hand of nations, and those hating them ruled against them,
⁴²and their enemies constricted them, and they were abased under their hand.
⁴³Abundant instances He rescued them, and they promoted defiance in their counsel, and were degraded in their perversity.
⁴⁴And He looked into their adversity in the hearing of their cheering.
⁴⁵And He remembered His covenant to them, and sighed according to His abundant lovingkindnesses.
⁴⁶And He gave them for cherishings before all those taking them captive.
⁴⁷Save us, Yahweh our God, and thoroughly amass us from the nations, to confess the name of Your holiness, to commend ourselves in Your praise.
⁴⁸Blessed is Yahweh, God of Israel, from the everlasting and until the everlasting. And all the people will say, "Truly! Praise Yah!"

Psalm 107

¹"Confess Yahweh, because He is good, because His lovingkindness is to everlasting,"
²those having been redeemed of Yahweh will say, whom He redeemed from the hand of an adversary,
³and thoroughly amassed from lands, from sunrising and from westward, from north and from the sea.
⁴They roved in the wilderness, in a desolation-way. They didn't find a city of dwelling.
⁵Hungry, also thirsty, their soul in them kept being feeble.
⁶And they cried to Yahweh in their adversity. From their distress He rescued them.
⁷And He caused them to tread in an upright way, to go to a city of dwelling.
⁸They will confess to Yahweh: His lovingkindness and His extraordinaries to sons of man.
⁹Because He has caused the ravening soul to be satisfied, and a hungry soul He has utterly filled with good,
¹⁰those dwelling in darkness and shade of death, prisoners of humiliation and iron,
¹¹because they promoted defiance at the sayings of God, and the counsel of the Most High they repudiated.
¹²And He abased their heart in toil. They stumbled and there were none helping.
¹³And they cried out to Yahweh in their adversity. He was saving them from their distresses.
¹⁴He caused them to exit from darkness and shade of death, and He intensely pulled apart their bands.
¹⁵They will confess to Yahweh: His lovingkindness and His extraordinaries to sons of man,
¹⁶because He has utterly broken doors of copper, and crossbars of iron He has intensely chopped off.
¹⁷Misosophists will utterly humiliate themselves from a way of their rebellion and from their perversity.
¹⁸Their soul abominates all food, and they touch at gates of death.
¹⁹And they have cried out to Yahweh in their adversity. He was saving them from their distresses.
²⁰He sends His word and heals them, and thoroughly effects their escape from their corruptions.
²¹They will confess Yahweh: His lovingkindness and His extraordinaries to sons of man,
²²sacrifices of confession, and recount His occupations in cheering.
²³Those going down to the sea in ships, doing handicraft in abundant waters,
²⁴these have seen the occupations of Yahweh and His extraordinaries in the deep.
²⁵And He has spoken, and He has caused a wind of a windstorm to stand, and it has utterly raised its waves high.
²⁶They go up to heavens. They go down to raging masses of water. Their soul thoroughly dissolves itself in evil.
²⁷They observe a holiday like the drunken, and all their wisdom intensely swallows itself.
²⁸And they cried out to Yahweh in their adversity, and He causes them to exit from their distresses.
²⁹Let Him cause a windstorm to arise to stillness, and their waves have been hushed.
³⁰And they have rejoiced because they are calmed, and He has caused them to be led to a harbor of their delight.

³¹They will confess Yahweh: His lovingkindness and His extraordinaries to sons of man,
³²and they will utterly raise Him high in an assembly of people, and in the seat of elders
they will praise Him.

³³May He set rivers for a wilderness, and exitings of waters for a thirsty ground,
³⁴a land of fruit for saltiness from the evil of those dwelling in it.
³⁵May He set a wilderness for a pond of waters, and a land of aridity for exitings of waters.
³⁶And He has caused hungry ones to dwell there, and they established a city of dwellings.
³⁷And they sowed fields, and planted vineyards, and they grew fruit of income.
³⁸And He blessed them, and made them abound greatly, and their animals weren't
lessened.

³⁹And they were little, and they were prostrate from restraint, evil, and grief,
⁴⁰He pouring out disdain on magnanimous ones, and He caused them to rove in a waste
with no way.

⁴¹And He set the needy aloft from humiliation, and He set families like sheep.
⁴²Upright ones will see and rejoice, and all injustice has drawn closed its mouth.
⁴³Who is wise and will keep these things, and always understand the lovingkindness of
Yahweh?

Psalm 108

A song. A psalm of David.

¹My heart is established, God. Let me sing and let me carol; moreover it will be my glory.
²Arouse yourself, viol and harp. Let me cause dawn to arouse itself.
³I will confess You among the peoples, Yahweh, and I will carol You in the countries,
⁴because great from above the heavens is Your lovingkindness, and unto the skies Your
truth.

⁵Raise Your glory high above heavens, God, and above all the earth Your glory.
⁶For the sake of Your dear one being delivered, save by Your right hand and answer us.
⁷God has spoken in His holiness: "Let me thoroughly divide Shechem, and I will thoroughly
measure the Valley of Shelters.

⁸Gilead is Mine, and Manasseh is Mine. Ephraim is a stronghold of My head, Judah My
legislator.

⁹Moab is a pot of My washing. Over Edom I am casting My sandal. Over Me, Philistia, I
will repeatedly shout."

¹⁰Who will cause me to stream to a city of fortification? Who has led me unto Edom?

¹¹Didn't You, God, abandon us? And You aren't exiting, God, with our armies.

¹²Provide help for us from adversity. But the saving of man is insubstantiality.

¹³In God we will exert ability, and He will stomp on our adversaries.

Psalm 109

To the director. Of David. A psalm.

¹God of my praise, You won't be silent,
²because the mouth of the wicked and a mouth of fraud have opened over me. They have spoken against me with a tongue of deception,
³and words of hatred. They have encompassed me and fought me for nothing.
⁴Instead of my love, they oppose me, and I resort to prayer.
⁵And they put evil upon me instead of good, and hatred instead of my love.
⁶Cause a wicked one to oversee him, and an opponent will stand upon his right hand.
⁷In his being judged he will exit wicked, and his prayer will be for a sin.
⁸His days will be few and a different one should be receiving his overseership.
⁹His sons will be fatherless, and his wife a widow,
¹⁰and his sons will wander – I emphasize “wander” – and beg and seek out from their dry places.
¹¹He who lends on usury will utterly snare all that is his, and strangers will spoil his labor.
¹²Don't let there be a drawing of lovingkindness for him, and don't let there be anyone showing benevolence to his fatherless ones.
¹³Let his posterity be for cutting off; in a following generation their name be wiped out.
¹⁴Iniquity of his fathers will be remembered to Yahweh, and may the sin of his mother not be wiped away.
¹⁵They will be before Yahweh continually, that He may cut their remembrance from the earth,
¹⁶forasmuch as he didn't remember to do lovingkindness, and he pursued the humble and needy man, that he might put to death those being discouraged.
¹⁷And he loved execration, and it entered him. And he didn't delight in blessing, and it was distant from him.
¹⁸And he wore execration as a tailored garment, and it entered like water in within him, and as oil into his bones.
¹⁹Let it be for him like a garment he cloaks in, and for a cinch he continually girds on.
²⁰This will be the preparation of those opposing me from Yahweh, and of those speaking evil over my soul.
²¹And You, Yahweh Lord, do with me for Your name's sake. Because Your lovingkindness is good, rescue me,
²²because I am humble and needy, and my heart pierced dead within me.
²³I have been made to go as a shadow when it stretches out. I have been shaken off like the locust.
²⁴My knees have stumbled from fasting, and my flesh has grown lean from its fatness.
²⁵And I have become a reproach to them. They see me. They cause their heads to wander.
²⁶Help me, Yahweh my God; cause me to be saved according to Your lovingkindness.
²⁷And they will know that this is Your hand, that You, Yahweh, have done it.
²⁸They will execrate, but I will bless You! They have arisen and are ashamed, but Your servant will rejoice.
²⁹My opponents will wear embarrassment and cloak themselves as with a mantle in their shame.
³⁰I will greatly confess Yahweh with my mouth, and in the midst of abundant ones I will praise Him,

³¹because He will stand to the right of the needy to save from those judging his soul.

Psalm 110

Of David. A psalm.

¹An affirmation of Yahweh to my Lord: "Sit to My right until I put Your enemies as a stool for Your feet."

²Yahweh will send the staff of Your strength from Zion. Have dominion in the midst of Your enemies!

³Your people will be magnanimous gifts in the day of Your ability. In splendors of holiness from the womb of dawning, Yours is the dew of Your childhood.

⁴Yahweh swore, and won't sigh: "You are a priest to everlasting of the situation of Melchizedek."

⁵The Lord upon Your right will have busted through kings in a day of His anger.

⁶He will adjudge among the nations. He will have filled with bodies. He will have busted through a head over an abundant land.

⁷He will drink from a brook in the way. Over thus He causes a head to be raised high.

Psalm 111

¹Praise Yah. I will confess Yahweh in all heart in the confidential communion of upright ones and the congregation.

²Great are the occupations of Yahweh, being sought out for all their delight,

³dignity and splendor His preparation, and His righteousness standing forever.

⁴He has made a remembrance for His extraordinaries. Benevolent and cherishing is Yahweh.

⁵He gave prey to those fearing Him. He will remember His covenant to everlasting.

⁶He has disclosed the vitality of His occupations to His people, to give to them an inheritance of nations,

⁷the occupations of His hands – truth and judgment. Sure are all His overseeing mandates,

⁸being upheld forever to everlasting, being done in truth, and upright.

⁹He sent a ransoming for His people. He has commanded His holy covenant to everlasting, and His name is being feared.

¹⁰A beginning of wisdom is the fear of Yahweh. Good insight is to all those practicing them, His praise standing forever.

Psalm 112

¹Praise Yah. Oh the happinesses of a man who has feared Yahweh! He has greatly delighted in His commands.

²His seed will be mighty in the earth. A generation of upright ones will be blessed,

³wealth and riches in his house, and his righteousness standing forever.

⁴Light has arisen for the upright ones in the darkness: benevolent, and cherishing, and righteous.

⁵Good is a man being benevolent and lending. He will constantly sustain his words with judgment,

⁶because to everlasting he won't be rocked. For an everlasting remembrance he will be righteous.

⁷He isn't fearing from an evil report, his heart being established, being made confident in Yahweh.

⁸His heart being upheld, he won't fear up to which time he will see against his adversaries.

⁹He has dispersed; he has given to needy ones, his righteousness standing forever. His horn will be raised high in glory.

¹⁰The wicked will see and be vexed. He will gnash his teeth and be melted. A longing of wicked ones will perish.

Psalm 113

⁶He goes – I emphasize "goes" – to weep, bearing that which is drawn of the seed. He will enter – I emphasize "enter" – in cheering, bearing his bundles.

A song of the ascending steps. Of Solomon.

¹If Yahweh won't build a house, those building have toiled for insubstantiality. If Yahweh won't keep a city, the one keeping has been vigilant for insubstantiality.

²It is insubstantiality for you being early to rise, to sit up late, eating bread of grief. Thus He gives sleep to His dear one.

³Behold: sons are an inheritance of Yahweh, the fruit of the womb a hire.

⁴Like arrows in a hand of a mighty man, thus are sons of the youth.

⁵O, the happinesses of the mighty man, who has thoroughly filled his arrow case from them. They won't be ashamed. They will speak with enemies in the gate.

Psalm 128

A song of the ascending steps.

¹O, the happinesses of everyone fearing Yahweh, walking in His ways!

²You will indeed eat of the exertion of your palms. Happy you! And good will be yours,

²³Who remembered toward us in our lowness, because His lovingkindness is to everlasting,
²⁴and tore us away from our adversaries, because His lovingkindness is to everlasting,
²⁵giving bread to all flesh, because His lovingkindness is to everlasting.
²⁶Confess to the God of the heavens, because His lovingkindness is to everlasting!

⁸Daughter of Babylon, being devastated, O, the happinesses of he who is recompensing to you your dealings which you dealt to us!

⁹O, the happinesses of he who takes hold of and intensely shivers your toddlers toward the crag!

Psalm 138

Of David.

¹I will confess You with all my heart. Before gods I will carol You.

²I will worship toward Your holy edifice and confess Your name over Your lovingkindness and over Your truth, because You have caused Your saying to be great above all Your name.

³In a day I called then You answered me. You cause me to prevail, strength in my soul.

⁴All kings of the earth will confess You, Yahweh, when they will have heard sayings of Your mouth,

⁵and they will sing in the ways of Yahweh, because great is the glory of Yahweh,

⁶because Yahweh is raised high, and He sees the low, but the high He knows from far away.

⁷Where will I go from Your Spirit? And where will I take flight from Your face?

⁸If I ascend the heavens, there You are; or should I sprawl out in Sheol, behold: You!

⁹I will lift wings of dawn that I should settle in a hind part of a sea.

¹⁰Also there Your hand will lead me, and Your right hand will hold me.

¹¹If I say, "Assuredly darkness will crush me," then night will be light unto me.

¹²Also, darkness isn't darkening from You, and night enlightens as the day; as in the darkness, so is the light.

¹³Because You have acquired my kidneys. You protectively covered me in my mother's womb.

¹⁴I will confess You over that by fearful things I have been made extraordinary. Your doings are extraordinaries, and my soul is knowing it very well.

¹⁵My power wasn't obscured from You when I was made in the concealment. I was intricately embroidered in lower places of earth.

¹⁶Your eyes saw my embryo, and upon Your scroll all of them were written: days formed, then not one among them.

¹⁷And how precious Your correlations have been to me, God ! How their heads have been powerful !

¹⁸I count them. They abound more than sand ! I woke up – and still with You !

¹⁹Would that You would assassinate the wicked, God ! And men of blood, turn aside from me !

²⁰Those who talk about You toward devices have taken up for insubstantiality – Your adversaries.

²¹Don't I hate those intensely hating You, Yahweh? And against those always rising up against You I am always loathing.

²²I have hated them with a finishing of hatred. They have become my enemies.

²³Examine me, God, and know my heart. Test me and know my perturbations,

²⁴and see if a way of grieving is in me, and lead me in a way everlasting.

Psalm 140

To the director. A psalm of David.

¹Deliver me, Yahweh, from an evil person; from a man of violences You must guard me,

²who imagine evils in heart. All day they sojourn for wars.

³They have sharpened their tongues just like a snake. Venom of an asp is under their lips.

¹¹A man of tongue won't be established in the earth. A man of violence, evil will hunt him for pressings.

¹²I have known that Yahweh will effect adjudication of the humble, the judgment of the needy.

¹³Assuredly, righteous ones will confess Your name; upright ones will dwell before Your face.

Psalm 141

A psalm of David.

¹Yahweh, I have called to You. Rush to me! Listen to my voice in my calling to You!

²My prayer will be established as incense before You, a burden of my palms as an evening offering.

³Set, Yahweh, a guard for my mouth. Guard over the door of my lips.

⁴Let not my heart be caused to stretch out to an evil word, to keep practicing practices in wickedness with men preparing iniquity. And I won't partake of the bread of their pleasantries.

⁸Because my eyes are toward You, Yahweh Lord, in You I have taken refuge; may You not bare my soul.

⁹Keep me from the hands of the trip-plate which they have laid as a trap for me, and from traps of those preparing iniquity.

¹⁰The wicked ones will fall into their own mesh together until I pass.

Psalm 142

An insight of David in his being in the cave. A prayer.

¹My voice cries to Yahweh. My voice intensely requests benevolence for itself to Yahweh.

²I pour out before Him my reflection; my pressure I disclose before Him.

³When my spirit remains feeble upon me, then You have known my pathway. In this path that I intensely walk they have secreted a trip-plate for me.

⁴Look right, and see that there is no one recognizing me; haven has perished from me. There is none seeking out my soul.

⁵I cried to You, Yahweh. I said, "You are my refuge, my share in the land of the living ones."

⁶Pay attention to my cheering, because I have been very destitute. Rescue me from those pursuing me, because they have been more vigorous than I.

⁷Cause my soul to exit from prison to confess Your name. Concerning me righteous ones will compass about, because You will deal with me.

Psalm 143

A psalm of David.

¹Yahweh, hear my prayer; listen to my pleas for benevolence. In Your faithfulness, answer me in Your righteousness.

²And You aren't entering into judgment with Your servant because no one living will be righteous before You.

³When an enemy pursued my soul, he smashed my life to the earth. He has caused me to sit in dark places like those dying of everlasting.

⁴And my spirit has remained feeble upon me; within me my heart remains desolated.

⁵I have remembered days from antiquity. I contemplate in all Your preparations; in the occupation of Your hands I intensely reflect.

⁶I thoroughly spread out my hands to You, my soul like a faint land to You. (Selah)

⁷Hurriedly answer me, Yahweh! My spirit is finished. You musn't conceal Your face from me, or I will be made similar with those going down to a pit.

⁸Cause me to hear Your lovingkindness in the morning, because in You I have been confident. Cause me to know the way that I go, because to You I have lifted my soul.

⁹Cause me to be rescued from my enemies, Yahweh. I have covered up to You.

¹⁰Teach me to do Your good pleasure, because You are my God. Your spirit is good; such will lead me into a land of equity.

¹¹For Your name's sake, Yahweh, You intensely enliven me; in Your righteousness You cause my soul to exit from pressure.

¹²And in Your lovingkindness You will ravage my enemies and cause all those distressing my soul to perish, because I am Your servant.

Psalm 144

Of David.

¹Yahweh is being blessed, my rock, teaching my hands for confrontation, my fingers for war,

²my lovingkindness, and my fortress, my lofty fastness, and my escaping for me, my buckler, and in Him I have taken refuge, the One putting down my people under me.

³Yahweh, what is man that You have known him, a son of man that You have so fully taken account of him?

⁴Man has been likened to futility, his days like a passing shade.

⁵Yahweh, stretch out Your heavens that You come down. Touch the mountains and they will smoke.

⁶Flash lightning and cause them to be scattered. Send Your arrows and You will havock them.

⁷Send Your hand from heights. Open me up and rescue me from abundant waters, from the hand of sons of an unfamiliar,

⁸whose mouth has spoken insubstantiality, and their right hand a right hand of deception.

⁹God, let me sing a new song to You. With a viol of ten strings let me carol to You,

¹⁰Who are giving saving to kings, opening up David His servant from an evil sword.

¹¹Open me up and rescue me from the hand of sons of an unfamiliar, whose mouth has spoken insubstantiality, and their right hand a right hand of deception,

¹²that our sons may be like plants, being made great in their youth, our daughters like lumbered angles, a pattern of an edifice,

¹³our garners full, facilitating from kind to kind, our flocks multiplying to thousands and intensely abounding in our outside places,

¹⁴Our cattle being made to bear, no bursting forth, and no exiting, and no squealing in our streets.

¹⁵O, the happinesses of the people for whom it is such! O, the happinesses of the people for whom Yahweh is its God!

Psalm 145

A praise of David.

¹I will utterly raise You high, my God, the King, and let me bless Your name to everlasting and forever.

²In every day I will bless You, and let me praise Your name to everlasting and forever.

⁷They will emit the remembrance of Your abundant goodness, and they will intensely cheer Your righteousness.

⁸Yahweh is benevolent and cherishing, slow of anger, and great of lovingkindness.

⁹Yahweh is good to all, and His cherishings are upon all His occupations.

¹⁰And all Your occupations will confess You, Yahweh, and Your kind ones will bless You.

¹¹They will tell of the glory of Your kingdom, and speak of Your mights,

¹²to make known to the sons of man His mights, and the glory of the splendor of His kingdom.

¹³Your kingdom is a kingdom of all eternities, and Your rule in every generation and generation.

¹⁴Yahweh is upholding all those falling, and uplifting all those being bowed down.

¹⁵The eyes of all are in anticipation toward You, and You are giving to them their food in time,
¹⁶opening Your hand and sating the good pleasure of all living.
¹⁷Yahweh is righteous in all His ways, and kind in all His occupations.
¹⁸Yahweh is near to all those calling on Him, to all those who call on Him in truth.
¹⁹He will do the good pleasure of those fearing Him, and will hear their pleading and save them.
²⁰Yahweh is keeping all those loving Him, but He will extirpate all the wicked ones.
²¹My mouth will speak the praise of Yahweh, and all flesh will bless His holy name to everlasting and forever.

¹⁰Yahweh reigns to everlasting, your God, Zion, to generation and generation. Praise Yah!

¹³because He has intensely toughened crossbars of your gates; He has blessed your sons within you.

¹⁴Setting your border in well-being, He sates you with the fat of wheat,

¹⁵sending His saying on the land until His word hurriedly runs.

¹⁶Giving snow like wool, He is dispersing hoarfrost like the ashes.

¹⁷Causing His frost to be cast like bits, before His cold who will stand?

¹⁸He sends His word and causes them to liquify. He causes His wind to breathe. Waters flow down,

¹⁹disclosing His words to Jacob, His legislations and His judgments to Israel.

²⁰He has not done thus with any nation, and neither have they known judgments. Praise Yah!

Psalm 148

¹Praise Yah! Praise Yahweh from the heavens; Praise Him in the heights!

²Praise Him, all His messengers; praise Him, all His armies!

³Praise Him sun and lunation; praise Him, all stars of light!
